### Netherlands: Opportunity for ASEAN Researchers to Work at Dutch Universities and Research Institutes. Deadline 1 November, 2016



The Visiting Professors Programme (VPP) offered by the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences enables outstanding foreign researchers to spend time working in the Netherlands. The Academy funds a research budget and covers the Visiting Professor's travel and accommodation expenses. The Dutch university acts as the host organisation. All disciplines are eligible. ### Thailand - France: Young Researcher Fellowship Program. Call Now Open. Deadline 25 October, 2016



The Junior Research Fellowship Program aims at jumpstarting the career of young Thai researchers by giving them the opportunity to develop promising collaboration with their French counterparts. This program supports Thai Post Docs to spend between 2 to 6 months working at a laboratory in France. Thai candidates must be completed their PhD by February, 2017 prior to leaving for France. ### Germany: DAAD Scholarships for Graduates from Developing and Newly Industrialised Countries



The scholarships offer foreign graduates from development and newly industrialised countries from all disciplines and with at least two years' professional experience the chance to take a postgraduate or Master's degree at a state or state-recognised German university, and in exceptional cases to take a doctoral degree, and to obtain a university qualification (Master's/PhD) in Germany. Chevening is the UK government's international awards scheme aimed at developing global leaders. MSCA-RISE will support short-term mobility of research and innovation staff at all career levels, from the most junior (post-graduate) to the most senior (management), including administrative and technical staff.
