10th Anniversary of the European Research Council (ERC). Europe Can Build on Scientific Intuition



ERC-funded scientists have won six Nobel prizes, five Wolf prizes and four Fields Medals. The ERC-funded projects have also resulted in 100,000 articles being published in scientific journals, including more than 5,500 in the 1% most-cited scientific journals. Germany: Collaborative projects in Sustainable Development of Urban Regions. Call Targets Southeast Asia. Deadline



The aim of the funding measure is to develop and test locally-adapted strategies for the sustainable development of urban regions and to encourage the strategies' permanent implementation in order to improve ecological factors (emissions, energy and resources efficiency, etc.) and increase urban resilience. This funding call is initially limited to the target regions of Southeast Asia (ASEAN countries) and China. Details [here](#).

ASEAN: Third Batch of SHARE Scholarships for ASEAN Students Open for Applications.



The scholarship provides fully funded, short-term (one semester) exchange of students from a network of 32 participating universities across the region. It is open to students who have completed at least two semesters of study and have been accepted to study at one of the participating universities. For this third batch, 125 scholarships are available for study in an ASEAN country. Additional 50 fully funded scholarships are available to spend one semester of study at one of the 8 participating universities in Europe. More information [here](#).

Italy: Master's Degree Programme in Civil and Environmental Engineering Scholarships. BSc Holders from Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar and Vietnam Eligible. Deadline 30 April, 2017



The University of Brescia is offering scholarships for students with a 3-year minimum Bachelor's Degree (or other eligible qualification) awarded in Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, and Vietnam who intend to enroll in the first year of the Master's Degree Programme in Civil and Environmental Engineering. France – AgreenSkills+ Postdoctoral Fellowships. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadlines 28 April & 13 October



AgreenSkills+ is an international mobility programme co-funded by the European Union's Seventh Framework Programme for research, technological development. The programme is aimed at talented researchers from all over the world holding a PhD with less than 10 years of postdoctoral research experience. Research projects in the fields of agriculture, food, nutrition, environment, animal health and veterinary public health may be supported. More information [here](#).

The eighth Open Science Meeting, entitled Towards Resilient Society, will be held from 15 to 17 May 2017 in Yogyakarta, Indonesia. The Falling Walls Fellowship for Journalists is aimed at journalists and bloggers with at least three years of experience, and who hope to advance their knowledge in the area of sciences. The Fellows get the opportunity to attend the Falling Walls Lab, Falling Walls Venture, the Falling Walls Conference as well as an additional programme in Berlin around 8 and 9 November 2017. The fellowship includes travel expenses (economy class), accommodation for 3 nights (organised by Falling Walls Foundation), conference fees and meals (breakfast at hotel, catering during the Falling Walls events). Students will be able to work in different fields of research, including experimental disciplines like genomics, transcriptomics, proteomics, metabolomics, and bioimaging as well as theoretical disciplines such as stochastics, bioinformatics, theoretical physics, and computational biology. Europe: European Respiratory Society (ERC) Short Term Fellowships. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 1 April/1 October, 2017




Short-Term Research Fellowships are established to enable young scientists and clinicians in the early-stages of their research career in respiratory medicine to visit a Host Unit in a (European) country other than the candidate's own, with the aim of learning a research technique not available in the Home Unit. The research training should benefit the Home Unit when the applicant returns there, by leading to research developments and activities back onsite. Details

Netherlands: Visitors Travel Grants. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Rolling Deadline



The Visitors' Travel Grant programme provides scholarships to highly qualified, foreign senior research graduates who make an important contribution to a Dutch research project. The programme aims to promote cooperation between Dutch and foreign researchers. With these grants researchers can stay in the Netherlands for up to 4 months. Continuous application.
